Full professor of City and Regional Planning (SSD ICAR / 20) at the Department of Architecture of the University of Ferrara (Unife) where he has been teaching since 1993. In Unife: he is one of the professors of the international doctorate in Architecture and Urban Planning ( IDAUP) since 2013; he was among the professors of the Doctorate in Economics in 2000-2012; he was director of the Master in City Management and of the European Master in Environmental Management and Sustainable Development in 1996-2001. At the Polytechnic of Turin he was director of the Urban Studies Center of the Corep-Consortium for research and lifelong education and coordinator of the European master in Territorial Planning and Real Estate Market in 1989-1993. At the Ministry of Foreign Affairs he was an expert analyst for projects in the health, education and housing sectors at the African Development Bank in 1984-1988. At the Politecnico di Torino he was a fellow and researcher at the Territory Department in 1977-1981. Following a public competition, he was selected as a collaborator for the Polytechnic and the Piedmont Region on the urban plan for the reconstruction of 12 municipalities of the Colloredo di Montalbano Hill Community after the 1976 Friuli earthquake.

Appointed Fulbright Scholar in 1981 at Harvard University. Achieved a 2-year Master in City and Regional Planning from J. F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, 1983. Research assistant at the Joint Center for Housing Research of Harvard and M.I.T., 1982-83. Scholarship holder C.N.R. for abroad, 1983. Attendance at a short specialization course at the Center for Real Estate of the M.I.T., Mass., United States, July 1990.

Responsible for the urban planning part of the first strategic urban plan of Italy, Turin International, 1998-2000. Project leader or project team member of numerous urban plans and strategic urban plans in Italy and abroad, including Turin, Perugia, Addis Ababa.

Architect, Polytechnic of Turin, 1977. Graduated English and French language diplomas at the highest levels at various universities and institutions (Cambridge University, Chicago University, Alliance Française, Université de Nice - Sophia Antipolis, La Rochelle Université, TOEFL), from 1974 to 1989.
